1. The topic of the Essay:

2. The proposed time lines are as follows:

- Felicitation of winners: 15.08.2023

4. The essay writing will be in two languages i.e., English and Telugu for two categories separately i.e., a. for students, b. General Public

5. There will be 1st, 2nd, 3rd prizes in each category in each language.

1 st prize	Rs. 10,000
2 nd Prize	Rs. 5,000
3 rd prize	Rs. 3,000

In addition there shall be 20 (Twenty) consolation prizes of Rs: 1,000/- each

Guidelines:

- a. All students and general public in Telangana are eligible to participate in two different categories.
- b. The essays can be written in two languages i.e., English / Telugu.
- c. The participants should send their essays either in word & PDF formats.
- d. The length of essay should not be more than 3000 words.
- e. The papers will be evaluated by the eminent professors based on their novelty of contribution, originality of thought, and the ability to stimulate interest.
